# Course Guide

- 9 Holes of FootGolf are on the first 3 holes and the 9th hole of the Foothills 9. FootGolf holes are two feet wide and have a yellow flag. FootGolf Tees are either on a tee box or just to the side of the previous hole you have played.
- Wait for your turn to tee off so that your “kick” will not interfere with other players. FootGolf holes are located on the sides of the fairways. If your ball comes to rest on a regular golf green, take a drop in the nearest long grass.
- Touching the ball with the bottom of your foot is not allowed at any time. The ball must be completely stopped before you kick it. The ball must be played ‘where it lies’. The only exception is to mark you ball so as to not interfere with another player.
- It should take about 1 hour to play all nine holes. Plan to play about 6 minutes per hole.
- Cleats **must not** be worn, runners are the best footwear for playing FootGolf.
- As in regular golf, the goal is to hole out in as few kicks as possible.
- Please rake footprints and ball marks in all sand traps. Each hole must be completed, there are no ‘gimmies’.
- Have some FootGolf FUN!
